ENTERTAINMENT DISTRICTS

East, West, and "Dirty" Sixth Street

Another short 15 minute ride away is Austin's 6th street entertainment district, the city's most storied, has developed into three separate & distinct entertainment enclaves by location and style.

The original entertainment section is Old 6th, fondly known as Dirty 6th, is considered a bit more "rowdy".

West 6th is an eclectic mix of historic and iconic venues and pool-top dance clubs and is an easy walk from Dirty 6th.

East 6th is the more laid back version of the iconic entertainment district, with neighborhood bars, lots of outdoor spaces, craft breweries, food trucks and great live music.
